Auburn University Montgomery Policies and Procedures

Title: Intimate Relations Policy

Responsible Office: Vice Chancellors

I. PURPOSE

Prohibit all faculty, administrators, and supervisors from engaging in romantic or sexual relationships with students, whom they are currently supervising or teaching.

II. POLICY

It is the policy of Auburn University at Montgomery to prohibit all faculty, administrators, and supervisors, including graduate teaching assistants, from pursuing and engaging in romantic or sexual relationships with students, both graduate and undergraduate, whom they are currently supervising or teaching.

III. EFFECTIVE DATE

September 3, 2009

IV. APPLICABILITY

This policy applies to all faculty and staff, both full and part-time.

V. RESPONSIBILITY

The provisions of this policy will be enforced by the appropriate Vice Chancellor.

VI. PROCEDURES

Violation should be promptly reported to the University's Office of Affirmative Action/Equal Employment Opportunity.

VII. SANCTIONS

Violations of this policy will be addressed through appropriate disciplinary action.

VIII. INTERPRETATION

The appropriate Vice Chancellor is responsible for any interpretations of this policy.
