 These letters must be printed on letterhead and signed

 Reasons for pursuing, and expectations of, the Instructional Leadership Master's

 Degree (limited to one page, typed double-spaced 12 point font with one inch margins)

 Accomplishments in Instructional Leadership field roles. Examples may include:

 Department Head or Grade level Leader, PST, Extended Day Programs

 Evidence of the ability to improve P-12 student achievement (limited to one page, typed double-spaced 12 point font with one page, typed double-spaced 12 point font with one inch margins). Examples include: Direct Instruction

 Building Level Leadership Teams, School Initiatives, Educate Alabama

 Philosophy Statement (limited to one page typed double-spaced 12 point font with one inch margins.)
