professional development component, if available.			
Evidence of <b>Leadership and Management Potential Form</b> (attached)			
<u>Letter of Intent</u> (to include the following sections in your letter)			
<ul> <li>Describe professional and career goals and reasons for pursuing an</li> </ul>			
instructional leadership certificate			
<ul> <li>Summary of what you expect from this program</li> </ul>			
<ul> <li>Evidence of your ability to improve student achievement</li> </ul>
